Budget Area of Work Spotlight

Budgeted funds for grounds maintenance at Eastern Meadows are primarily spent on two contracts, one for mowing and the other for chemical treatments. The mowing contract was bid out two years ago, and overall, we have been very happy with the service we are getting. The chemical treatments were bid out last year, resulting in some savings and what we think is good, consistent service. Those two contracts require close to \$900 per month to keep Eastern Meadows looking like an inviting location for worship and fellowship. What those two contracts do not provide we can fill in by having a few work days and maybe a separate project here and there, if we want to beautify or improve a certain area of the property. We have budgeted \$1000 for the year for small purchases of topsoil, weed killer, replacement shrubs, and such things related to those efforts. There are several deacons helping with Grounds this year but not many members at large. Therefore, the deacons will be calling for any and all volunteers from throughout the congregation whenever there is a work day or a project, and they are hoping you will come to their aid! —


